Energex Contestable Works

Consent to the Erection of Electric Line (Wayleave Application)

Introduction:

Energex Contestable Works department and Network Data have recently reviewed the processing of Wayleaves and the completion of Form 1146 – Energex Consent to the Erection of Electric Line (Wayleave Application) .

This update is to confirm the correct Real Property Description requirements on Form 1146 for properties that are to be Subdivided with crossings on the new lots along with the timing of the submissions.

Form 1146 - Section 1 – Real Property Description:

- This section must include the following:
- 1. New road name and address if applicable. Existing address where there is no new address.
- 2. New lot number and Survey Plan number
- 3. Cancelling lot and plan number.
- 4. Parish – No longer mandatory

Wayleaves in Principle:

- Wayleaves are required to be submitted to Energex Contestable Works team prior to construction of the Energex electrical infrastructure.
- If all the details are not available at this time, (e.g. new lot & plan number), the Wayleave must still be submitted to Contestable Works team and will be considered a “Wayleave in Principle”.
- This confirms consent of the impacted property owners.

Completion Package – Wayleave submission:

- At this time, the Wayleaves are required to be reviewed by the consultant, and if required, completed with all details and re-signed by the impacted property owner.
- Detailed drawing of the crossing/s must accompany the Wayleave.
- The surveyor signed Survey Plans must accompany the Wayleave.

Certificate of Supply – No Project required – Wayleave submission:

- The above conditions also apply for Certificates of Supply where no works are required.

Implementation Date

This process is effective from 20 July 2020.
