Introduction

This update provides the targeted audience with information in relation to the updated application forms for Contestable Works Subdivisions & Public Lighting where the Developer is related to a Trust / Trustee.

Application Forms

Agreement Entity Name (Developer) is related to a Trust / Trustee.

When entering into an Agreement with Energy Qld on behalf of a Trust, an application form and a copy of the original Deed must be provided to the Contestable Works team. A trust entity which is registered with ASIC as a Discretionary Trading Trust cannot itself enter into a contract. Instead, the trustee of the trust must enter into a contract on behalf of the trust. Although the trustee(s) of the trust are bound under an implied agreement by any obligations under the NCEC / SESA, receiving a copy of the original Deed shall ensure that the correct party (I.e. a trustee for the Trust) enters into the NCEC / SESA and the refundable Bond Payment is processed efficiently.

Implementation Date:

These changes are effective immediately on all Contestable Works Applications where the Developer is related to a Trust / Trustee.
