Retirement of Ergon RSC Documents

Introduction:

As a result of the introduction of the Contestable Works Accredited Service Provider Rating Terms (Rating Terms), this operational update outlines the retirement of the following Ergon Energy Network specifications:

- RSC07 UDC Civil Works
- RSC08 UDC Electrical Works
- RSC09 UDC Horizontal Direction Drilling
- RSC10 UDC Electrical Testing

General

The Rating Terms were introduced across Energy Queensland Limited (EQL) in 2024, and they are fully implemented for both the Energex and Ergon Energy Network DNSP areas. As such all ASPs hold a rating compliant with one or multiple Work Category Specifications (WCSs). This replaced the previous documents related to the Energex WCQA Rating Terms and the Ergon Contractor Rating Guidelines. Hence, all legacy documents are now obsolete, and ASPs must comply with the WCSs.

What Next?

For the Ergon Energy Network DNSP, there are several test documents that were contained in the RSC documents. Replacements for these have been provided on the Ergon Energy Network website via the Ergon Energy Network [Technical Documents webpage](#) under the Ergon Developer Design and Construct Estates section. ASPs are welcome to use these documents or develop their own fit for purpose test documentation.

Note this page includes a dual branded **Certificate of Completion**, which is to be submitted at the completion of both civil and electrical works.

Design Consultants shall cease the practice of referring to the RSC documents on works plans, as they no longer apply.

Any existing works plans referring to the obsolete documents prepared hitherto this update, shall be ignored and the ASP shall refer to the relevant WCS(s) and DNSP standards.
